## Ministry in Saint-Louis, Senegal ....among the Wolof

We've completed our third term in Senegal and God has really blessed the ministry among the Wolof people. We now have a functioning primary school that grows each year. The Leer Gi School opened on October 21,



2008. The preschool class started with 6 children and now with 2 new grades, the school has grown to almost 70. We currently have three full time teachers and a director.

The Assemblies of God church was started in 2007 and has seen several people saved and two baptized in the last four years. The Leer Gi radio program airs 3 times a week in Saint-Louis. We've also been given 30 minutes of free airtime each Sunday morning at 9:30am. Radio ministry has been an affective way to reach out to our community with the love of Christ. We look forward to what the Lord has for us in our fourth term.

## Looking Toward the Future



In our fourth term we'll be working to see the church expand in places where it has never been before. In Senegal, this not only means strengthening the church but also finding new ways for the church to present the Kingdom to all the people of Senegal. We believe that by enabling the church to reach out to the community, the Gospel will be heard.

To this end, we'll be opening another Christian school; this time in Matam, Senegal. Matam is located along the north eastern border and is the home of the Tukulor people. The Tukulor are part of the Fulani people group and are one of the largest unreached peoples in the world. Once again we'll be working with a Senegalese pastor to start a church in conjunction with the school, helping Christian teachers move into areas of Senegal where the Gospel must be heard.
